Church Standards -

Campers using Aspen View property are expected to maintain the modes dress standards of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints. Two priesthood brethren at all Girls' Camps. Priesthood brethren are expected to challenge all visitors they do not recognize.

General Safety -

- Those using the property accept the risk of injury or damage during their stay. Please take appropriate safety precautions.
- Children under age 12 must be supervised all times. Youth groups 12 thru 18 must have at least two adult priesthood leaders. There should be at least one leader per 5 youth.
- Obey the posted speed limit of 15 mph.
- Stay within the Aspen View boundaries or get permission to hike on other stake properties.
- Limit noise especially after dark.
- Conserve water
- Bring an adequate first aid kit.
- Bring lanterns.
- Make a fire evacuation plan with your group.
- Cell phone service is available in remote areas on road and in camp.
- Do not park on the main road. Park at least 10 feet off the road or in the parking lot.
- Respect the wildlife
- Do not cut or damage trees or shrubs or pick the wildflowers.
- Prohibited items: ATV's, firearms and all fireworks.

Camp sites-

- Leave camp sites better than you found them. Practice "no trace camping".
- If you move the tables, put them back.
- Step ladders are available in restrooms.

Fire Safety -

Aspen View property is in a National Forest. The fire marshal will post signed if fires are not permitted. The Fire Marshall's phone number is: 801-538-5555.

If fires are allowed:

- Use existing fire pits. No open fires.
- You are welcome to use any dead trees around the property for firewood, but it is probably best to bring your own. Please do not cut any tree that is still standing.

- Do not use flammable liquids to start fires.
- Use the mesh screen to stop flying embers.
- Never leave a fire unattended.
- Have a filled 5-gallon bucket of water near the pit.
- Extinguish fires completely.

Pavilion -

- There are lights in the pavilion, but you need to run the generator to use them. The generator is in the shed. The generator needs to be on a flat surface.
- Tarps can be clipped onto the pavilion for shade. They are in the shed.
- Tables should be left clean. Please hose off any spills.
- Floor should be hosed down. The hose is in the shed.

Restrooms-

- Restrooms and showers have solar lights.
- The restrooms are stocked with toilet paper and cleaning supplies. Please replace what you use. Brooms and mops are provided.
- Warm water is supplied by propane heaters. **Do not adjust the water heaters or tanks.**
- Showers should be limited.
- Conserve water - take short showers. Turn off all water taps and running toilets.
- Restrooms are connected to septic tanks. **Do not put trash of any kind down the toilets.**
- Leave all restrooms and showers clean and please mop floors. **Follow posted cleaning instructions.**
- Use only existing restrooms to maintain a clean water supply.

Trash-

- **CARRY OUT ALL TRASH - Do not put trash in dumpsters by the freeway.** Use dumpsters at your stake/ward building or home.

Zipline -

- Only one-person rides at a time.
- No infants or small children.
- Weight limit is 250 pounds.
- Must always have adult or youth camp leader supervision.
- Place a gloved hand on the wheel and apply pressure as needed to control descent, this will also stop any wobbling of the wheel.
